- Red Hill Fuel Spill & USS Bonhomme Richard

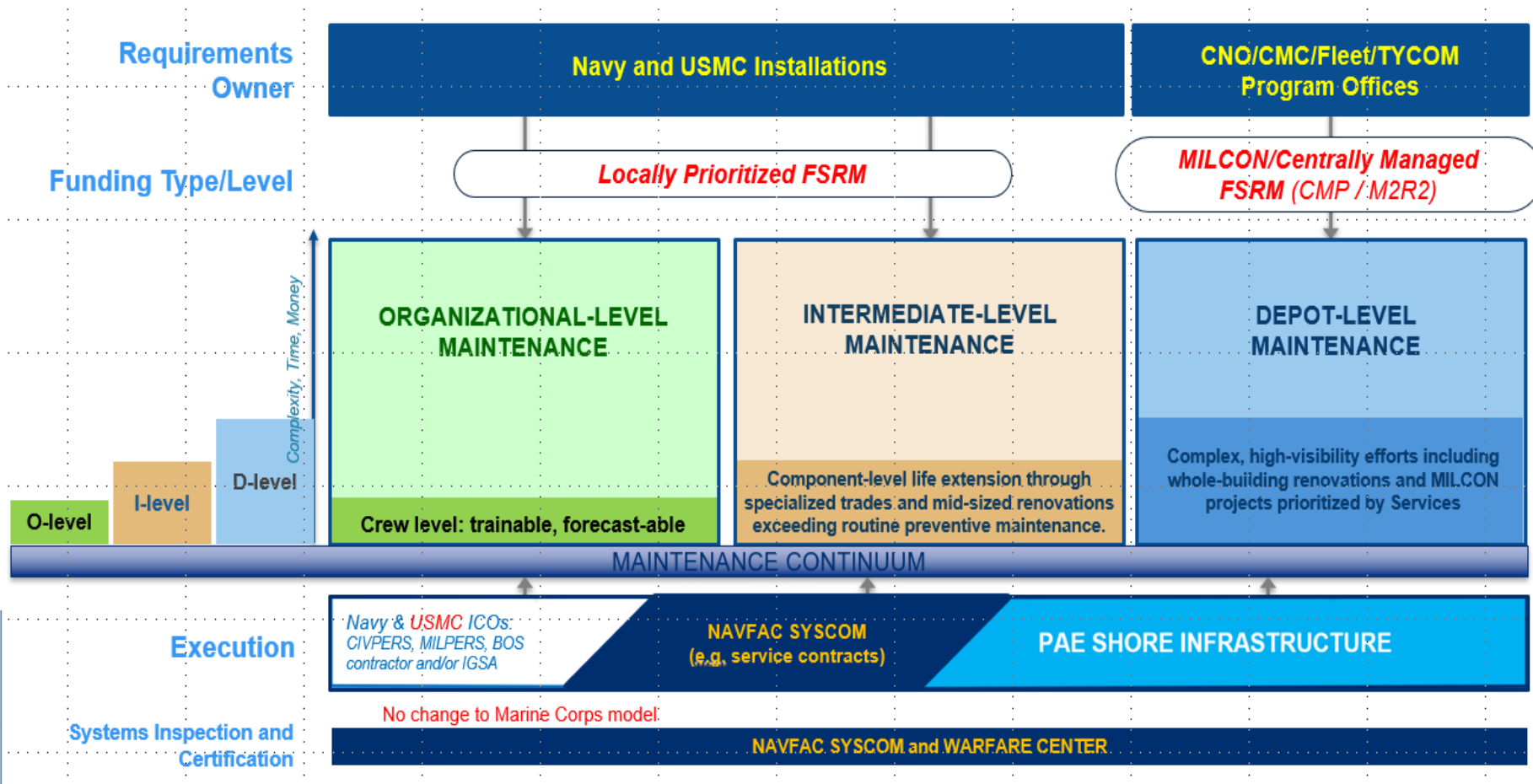

- Laser-focus on Navy Military Construction & the most Critical Infrastructure Sustainment, Restoration & Modernization (SRM) Projects
- Shed non-Navy work (reimbursable work)
- Turnover the Publics Work Operations & Maintenance to CNIC

NAVFAC of the Future – The How

- Two Orgs – PAE SI (Shore Infrastructure) & NAVFAC SYSCOM
- PMO (Program Management Offices) structures supporting PAE execution machine (10-13 PMOs)
- SYSCOMs to provide back-office support functions
- Pre-Award MILCON and CMP program managed centrally and executed out of four locations (Hawaii, San Diego, Norfolk, & Jacksonville) – no plans to retrograde anything in transition
- Post-Award executed by OICCs/ROICCs (today's FECs and FEADs)
- PWDs to CNIC NLT 20 SEP 2026 - Additionally, CYBER, portion of Env., Fac. Support Contract Quality Assurance
- Waiting on final PAE / SYSCOM reorg design from Navy
- PAE Shore Infrastructure – full design underway

NAVFAC PAE Reorg

- Yesterday's Field Engineering & Architecture Divisions (FEADs) at PWDs become ROICCs – already happened
- ROICC consolidation happens across most FEC AORs – planned
- FECs become OICCs – Post Award Machines
- **PAE Shore Infrastructure (PAE SI)**
 - Current NAVFAC SYSCOM Chief (2-Star) leads this organization
 - At the highest level: Pre-Award and Post-Award
 - Pre-Award will be laser-focused on design of MILCON & Large Navy SRM Projects (pre-dominantly Design-Build (DB) & employment of Special Construction Authorities
 - Geographical work boundaries will only exist at the PAE LANT & PAC level – the current 1-Stars will continue to be aligned to the respective Fleets (double-hatted)
 - Today's Field Engineering Commands (FECs) become laser-focused on Post Award Construction and Cost Management - morph to OICC offices
 - ROICC alignment has not been decided (Echelon III or OICC?)
- **Most of back-office support will be centralized within a single NAVFAC SYSCOM structure**

So, What does this mean to you?

- **First, Acquisition Strategy decisions have been moved to NAVFAC HQ**
 - In the future they will be made at the Pre-Award PAE HQ level
 - PMO involvement at Echelon II level will ensure improved resourcing plans
- **Design will be done mostly through Design-Build (DB) vice Design-Bid-Build (DBB) and employment of alternative acquisition methods**
 - Better, Faster? We don't have a choice. Manpower constraints force our hand
 - We recognize the shift in dynamic this causes but it's a non-negotiable outcome
- **Acquisition tools we were awarding locally will be taken over by more centralized tools in the future**

Acquisition Reform New Authorities

- 1. ADB – Accelerated Design-Build**
- 2. OTA – Other Transactional Authority**
- 3. MYP – Multiyear Procurement**
- 4. PDB – Progressive Design-Build**

Acquisition Authorities

(1 of 4)

- **Accelerated Design-Build (ADB)** – strategically untethers the initial design phase from the traditional, rigid MILCON funding timeline
 - NDAA 2026 Section 2809, 10 USC 3241(f)
 - Early Award: ADB allows NAVFAC to award the design portion of a design-build contract prior to receiving the full project authorization and appropriation from Congress – will reduce time between construction authority and start – expect up to 18-months
 - HQs current list includes 2 projects in 27 and 3 in 28 – prelim designs in progress – more projects to be added

Acquisition Authorities

(2 of 4)

- **Other Transactional Authorities (OTA)** – a permanent authority that enables the DOW to bypass traditional FAR constraints for facility repair and construction projects
 - 10 USC 2808a – Acq. Authority has to be delegated from ASN RD&A
 - Enables the use of transactions other than contracts (cooperative agreements, grants for facility repair and construction)
 - Allows us to use customized terms and conditions tailored to project-specific needs while utilizing commercial industry best practice
 - A follow-on transaction for production may be entered into w/o further competition if a complete and useable facility was successfully completed in the original transaction
 - Right now, planned use for FY27 and out is Barracks and Child Development Centers
 - FY27 - 13 Barracks and 10 CDCs (\$2.8B)

Acquisition Authorities

(3 of 4)

- **Progressive Design-Build (PDB)** – a collaborative, two-phase construction delivery method where the design-builder is selected primarily based on qualifications, rather than lowest bid
 - NDAA 2026
 - Unlike traditional DB, the final price is established after the owner and builder have collaboratively progressed the design, to a point where risks and costs are well-understood
 - Under PMB, the final guaranteed maximum price is NOT established at the time of award – will avoid major change orders later
 - Initial projects to implement likely will be PDB via OTA – considering waterfront Production Facilities
 - Aligns federal construction with the preferred delivery methods used by the private sector for large, complex projects; ensuring cost certainty before breaking ground

Acquisition Authorities

(4 of 4)

- **Multiyear Procurement (MYP)** – allows NAVFAC to contract for a series of repeatable facilities over multiple years using available MILCON appropriations
 - NDAA 2026, Section 2809
 - Authorized for certain repeatable projects, like barracks and CDCs
 - SECNAV certification required to prove MYP cost savings is at least 10% compared to individual annual contracts
 - Current Targeted Opportunities: FY28-30 MCBI Barracks; FY28-30 Navy CDCs; INDOPACOM projects (FY29-31)

Key Takeaways

- **PAE SI will direct Big “A” Strategy from now on – I am but a humble messenger of those decisions**
- **When planning out-year projects, shift away from traditional firm-fixed price design-build contracts for complex facilities**
- **If a project carries high technical risk or unknown costs, default to PDB**
- **If we need to cut years off a delivery schedule and have early design funding, leverage ADB**
