


- **Significant emphasis of the NAVFAC SE contractor safety program:**

# NAVFAC SE Contractor Mishap Rates




- ✓ NAVFAC SE contractors are consistently 70% - 55% below industry average.

# Safety is a Stand Alone Factor



- **Does the narrative describe the technical approach to safety for its employees?**
- **Does the narrative describe the plan the offeror will be implementing to evaluate and measure safety performance of potential subcontractors as a part of the selection process for all levels of subcontractors?**
- **Does the narrative describe the methods that the offeror will employ to ensure and monitor safe work practices of all subcontractors?**
- **Is the narrative limited to 3 pages?**

# Self-Reported Near Misses



- **Near miss reporting is anchored as one of the top safety measurement indicators for NAVFAC safety.**
- **NAVFAC encourages and promotes near miss reporting from our contracting partners through the following methods:**
  - **Highlight near miss reports in local publications**
  - **Acknowledgement of the contractor's safety program as always improving**
  - **Clearly demonstrates leadership's active role in mishap prevention**
